Set for Summer Concert Series



Aged Care Training

To support local recruitment in aged care for the region, West Coast TAFE in 2007 is launching a four week pre-employment training course to determine those best suitable to go on to complete the Certificate 3 in Aged Care as a trainee.

The four week course will consist of training in occupational health and safety, communicating in the workplace and patient care, as well as two days a week in volunteer student placement.

West Coast TAFE has approached several local aged care facilities in the region that have signalled their support for the program, as it will assist facilities in recruiting new and suitable aged care workers. At the end of the course students will sit an interview with an aged care facility manager to determine their suitability for further study as a trainee.

This program targets long-term unemployed, career changers and stay-at-home mothers looking for work where there are many rewarding and satisfying career opportunities.

Students that have completed a Certificate 3 in Aged Care can also study to become an enrolled nurse, while working in aged care, by completing the Diploma in Enrolled Nursing, one day per week at West Coast TAFE over two years.


The office is located at Club Capricorn's Zodiac Room and is open on Wednesday afternoons from 2pm to 5.30pm.

New Joint Venture at Yanchep

St Andrews Private Estate (SAPE) has formed a joint venture with the Singaporean Orion Group to develop a new major project in Yanchep/ Two Rocks.

The new entity will be called the Yanchep Beach Joint Venture and its project area incorporates land to the east of the Capricorn Village Joint Venture and around the Sun City Golf course.

The 625-hectare development will include a regional town centre, complete with "business clusters" to drive employment, approximately 250 hectares of residential land around the Sun City Golf Course Estate and "light industrial" land for the greater St Andrews project.

SAPE Managing Director Nobu Kawasaki said that with The Orion Group already building a development in the area the new joint venture will be able to draw on a wealth of local knowledge for the project.

"We are very proud to be involved with such a well respected group," Mr Kawasaki said.

"They have a reputation for delivering projects on time and have a wealth of experience in bringing creative diversified outcomes to new urban developments.

The Orion Group specialises in prestige "commercial" developments, such as its highly successful Meadow Springs shopping centre development north of

Mandurah.

Orion Director Mr Ang Gin Wah said the project offered exciting opportunities.

"The joint venture is going to bring the latest and best approaches to creating new communities where people can live work and recreate," he said.



Yanchep Sun City Update



I am very pleased to reflect on significant progress made on the St Andrews Project in 2006.

As you know, the St Andrews District Concept Plan was endorsed by the City of Wanneroo Council in February 2006, after which it was submitted to the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) for noting. This Plan provides the framework for the development of the statutory District Structure Plan (DSP) that will guide the project's development into the future. The DSP is currently in preparation and will be submitted to the City of Wanneroo for its approval in early 2007, after which it will be assessed by the WAPC.

A recent exciting development was the signing of a new joint venture agreement between St Andrews Private Estate Pty Ltd (SAPE) and the Orion Group from Singapore. This joint venture (Yanchep Beach Joint Venture) will lead to the development of the southern area's town centre, an employment and mixed-use area and a residential estate. We look forward to this joint venture with confidence and expectation.

The Capricorn Village Joint Venture project, of which YSC is a partner, is proceeding. Its land releases are in great demand and the building program is underway. With the aged care facility and housing already under construction, we expect the project to make a major impact next year, together with the final planning and construction of Marmion Avenue to Yanchep.

Most importantly, I wish you a Merry Christmas as it approaches and Happy New Year for 2007. It promises much progress for all of us.


